PARKING AMENDMENT

Amendment to be made part of the <u>Unit Property Act</u>

<u>Declarations of Claire E. Fox for Fox Hill Towne House</u>

<u>Condominiums.</u>

Each Condo unit was assigned <u>one</u> parking space. The Code of Regulations is as follows:

When Condo owner or lessee moves it shall be understood that the assigned parking space shall be assigned to the next owner or lessee.

In the event there is an excess of two cars per Condo, and parking becomes a problem, the owners of three or more cars must park the third car on the street.

No owner or lessee shall bargin, switch, or re-assign parking space with another Condo occupant.

If Condo member does not own a car, this space shall remain empty for their use and their use only.

It shall be up to each individual Condo member to control their assigned parking space. If a severe problem occurs, it shall be turned over to the Fox Hill Condo Association for further action.

In the event of snow, ice, or catastrophic conditions, controlled parking shall be suspended until such event ceases. Parking regulations shall resume when conditions are safe and normal. Determination to be that of Condo Manager.

Owners and/or occupants are required to park between the painted lines.

In the case of violations of this Amendment, the Condo Association, through its manager, shall issue for the 1st violation, a warning notice; allowing two days to comply with regulations. Second violation will subject violator to a fine of \$25.00 with subsequent violations subject to a fine of \$50.00 each occurence. Unpaid fines will accrue interest at the rate of 6% after the 15th day of non-payment. Fines to be issued at 15 day intervals.
