Atlantic County offers Single Stream Recycling! These items can all be put in the same container! **Do not put recyclables in plastic bags!** The following items are recyclable: paper products, cartons, office paper, newspaper, paper bags, food/cereal boxes, aluminum cans, steel/tin cans, aerosol cans, glass bottles and jars, plastics numbered 1-7, food containers and flower pots. Newspapers should be bound together with twine, all boxes must be broken down and tied together. Recyclables must be in the blue cans or a can with a recyclable sticker on it or they will not be picked up. TV's, Radios, Computer Equipment and other electronic items can be recycled at your local Best Buy store.
