Property Inspection:

On May 18th a property inspection was done. There are a couple of issues in the common areas.

1. 8 Trees in the front of some homes are diseased, dying or dead. Jboys Landscaping will taking those trees to ground level. They will be replaced in the fall.
2. Basins—the mouths are clogged so some work will have to be done to open them back up. That is being looked into now.
