LABOR DAY

Try this scrumptious homemade marinade!!

- 1/4 cup balsamic vinegar
- Juice of 1 lemon
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 2 tablespoons Dijon mustard
- 2 tablespoons brown sugar, packed
- 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 1/2 teaspoon dried thyme
- 1/2 teaspoon dried oregano
- 1/4 teaspoon dried rosemary
- Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper, to taste
- 4 boneless, skinless chicken breasts
- 2 tablespoons chopped, fresh parsley leaves



Marinate raw chicken for 1 to 24 hours. Reserve 1/4 cup for basting while grilling. Grill 5-6 minutes each side. Garnish with fresh, chopped parsley if desired.
