PATIOS & BALCONY RULES

Patios and balconies are not be used as storage areas. Appropriate outdoor lawn/patio furniture, umbrellas, grills and potted plants are permitted. No flammable materials of any kind are to be used/stored on balconies or concrete floor surface off the back glass slider doors.

BULK TRASH

Bulk trash items are <u>not</u> to be left at the dumpster container without prior notification to the property management company. There is an additional charge for removal of bulk items and the cost will be passed on to the unit owner/tenant responsible. Failure to comply will result in a fine along with the cost of removal.



PET WORRIES

Please note the pet restrictions per the Condo Association Rules & Regulations:

Pets are not permitted to run loose or uncontrolled at any time, anywhere within Ryan's Ridge common areas or grounds.

Pets must be on a leash at all times when they are outside with the owner/tenant of the residence.

All pet waste must be cleaned up immediately by the pet owner and disposed of properly.

NO SMOKING!

Smithville Fourth of July Parade—

There are scheduled to be more than 170 units in the Fourth of July parade that kicks off 9 a.m. Saturday July 4, 2022 at the Smithville Town Center.

The annual parade will follow its usual route east on Smithville Boulevard to Moss Mill Road and then west on Moss Mill to Historic Smithville.

Up to 10,000 people are expected to line the parade route, with many following the fire apparatus closing the parade to an Independence Day ceremony in Smithville's Village Greene.

The parade route will be blocked off to local traffic at 8:30 a.m.

WINDOWS & DOORS

Doors, storm doors, rear sliders and windows are the homeowner's responsibility.

An Exterior Change Request is required for any changes to your home including windows and doors. You can reach out to Michele Balch, Community Manager for and ECR.

All frames are to be brown to match the existing trim or it will have to be painted dark brown. A fine will be assessed to your account monthly until your unit is in accordance with the rules & regulations of Ryan's Ridge Condominium Association.

An inspection will be done before July 31st.

Fines will be applied if your unit is not in compliance.
